
What is Protected Health Information (PHI)?

PHI is any piece of information in an individual's medical record that was created, used, or disclosed during the course of diagnosis or treatment that can used to personally identify them



Other forms of PHI include: health plan beneficiary number, device identifiers, serial numbers, web URLs, IP address, biometric identifiers, full-face photos, etc.
